To use OpenType features in Adobe Photoshop, open the OpenType panel via Window > Characters. This panel lets you apply alternate characters, such as standard ligatures, by clicking the “fi” icon. Note that available features may vary by font, so use the Glyphs panel to explore the specific characters in a font.

## 2. Using Fonts in Canva

To Using fonts on Canva, follow these steps:

1. **Create Your Design:** Log in to Canva and choose your design type.
2. **Add a Text Box:** Click "Text" and select "Add a text box" for your custom text.
3. **Upload Font:** Go to "Font," select "Upload a Font," and upload your .OTF font.
4. **Manage Your Font on Mac:** Use Font Book to view installed fonts, check special characters, and copy them (Command + C).
5. **Paste in Canva:** Select your text box in Canva and paste the copied characters (Command + V), ensuring font is selected.

## 1. Using Fonts in Illustrator

To using fonts on Illustrator, follow these steps:

1. **Open the OpenType Panel:** Go to **Window > Type > OpenType**.
2. **Choose Your Text:** Select the text object to modify.
3. **Enable Features:**
  - Standard Ligatures
  - Contextual Alternates
  - Discretionary Ligatures
  - Figure Type (old-style or lining)
  - Character Position
4. **Explore Glyphs:** Access the **Glyphs panel** via **Window > Type > Glyphs** for alternate characters.
5. **Apply Changes:** Click options in the OpenType panel to modify text.

Note: Feature availability depends on the OpenType font. Enjoy enhancing your typography!

- Include the provided web-font files (WOFF, WOFF2) in your website's directory.
- Use the appropriate CSS code to load the web font. Example:

```
@font-face {  
  font-family: 'YourFont';  
  src: url('YourFont.woff2') format('woff2'),  
       url('YourFont.woff') format('woff');  
  font-weight: normal;  
  font-style: normal;  
}
```

Apply the font to your website by including the **font-family** property in your CSS.
