The download and file formats

When you download any of our products, the file you receive is delivered in ZIP format. You first must unzip this download.

- On Windows, right click on the ZIP and select "Extract All"
- On Apple Mac, right click on the ZIP and select "Open"

Once unzipped you will see the various font folders included, one for each font. Within each folder you will see two font files. One in OTF format, the other in TTF format. Both formats will work exactly the same as each other.

When it comes to installation (detailed below), you only need to install one version, not both. It doesn't matter which.

If you want to use these fonts on Cricut, Silhouette, SCAL, Adobe Design Suite, Paint, Word, PowerPoint, Corel Draw or any other desktop design/craft program you only need to install the fonts on your computer once, not on the programs themselves.

Unlike graphics, which need to be opened in each specific program. Fonts only require a generic install once on your computer to work on any of the above programs.

How to Install Fonts

On Windows 7, 8 or 10

1. Start by unzipping the downloaded file.
2. Right click on either font file (OTF or TTF) and select Install.

Windows Vista

1. From the 'Start' menu select 'Control Panel.'
 2. Then select 'Appearance and Personalization.'
 3. Then click on 'Fonts.'
 4. Click 'File', and then click 'Install New Font.'
- If you don't see the File menu, press 'ALT'.
5. Navigate to the folder that contains the fonts you want to install.
 6. Select the fonts you want to install.
 7. Press the 'Install' button to install the fonts.

Windows XP

1. From the 'Start' menu select 'Control Panel.'
2. Select the 'Appearance and Themes' category.
3. Select 'Fonts' from the 'See Also' panel at the left of the screen.
4. In the Fonts window, select the 'File menu', and choose 'Install New Font.'
5. Navigate to the folder that contains the fonts you want to install.
6. Select the fonts you want to install.
7. Press the 'OK' button to install the fonts.

How to Install Fonts

On Apple Mac

1. Double click on either the OTF or TTF file.
2. When the pop up preview window appears, click "Install Font".

Procreate

1. Click Actions > Add > Add Text.
2. Click Edit Style > Import Font.

You can now browse through the Files app to the folder where you saved your font. Click it to import it, and it will appear in the Fonts list in Procreate

Canva

Please note to add your own font purchases for use on Canva, you must have a Canva Pro membership.

1. Open your project.
2. Select your text area.
3. Click the font dropdown.
4. Click "Upload a font" at the bottom of the list.
5. Click "Upload a new font" from your brand kit page.
6. Select your font from your saved files.
