Font Installation and Usage Documentation

This document provides comprehensive information on installing fonts on Mac and Windows, using web fonts.

1. Installing Fonts on Mac

To install fonts on Mac, follow these steps:

1. Download the font files (TTF or OTF format).
2. Double-click the downloaded font file.
3. The Font Book application will open automatically, displaying a preview of the font.
4. Click 'Install Font' to add the font to your system.

2. Installing Fonts on Windows

To install fonts on Windows, use these steps:

1. Download the desired TTF or OTF font file.
2. Right-click on the font file.
3. From the context menu, choose 'Install.' This will automatically install the font for all applications.

3. Using Web Fonts

Web fonts allow seamless integration into websites:

- Include the provided web-font files (**WOFF**, **WOFF2**) in your website's directory. - Use the appropriate CSS code to load the web font. Example:

```
@font-face { font-family: 'YourWebFont';  
src: url('yourfont.woff2') format('woff2'),  
url('yourfont.woff') format('woff');  
fontweight: normal; font-style: normal;  
}
```

Include the font-family in your CSS to use it in your website's content.

4. Font Formats: PostScript vs. TrueType

PostScript (Type 1):

- Developed by Adobe in the 1980s, widely used in professional printing. It has two files: one for outline data and one for font metrics.

TrueType: - Developed by Apple and Microsoft, TrueType is used in both print and screen environments. It is compatible with Mac and Windows systems and includes both outline data and font metrics in one file (.TTF).
