

# Authentype Studio –Font Installation & Usage Guide

## 1. INSTALLING FONTS ON DESKTOP

To install the font on your desktop:

- macOS: Double-click the .OTF/.TTF file and click 'Install Font'.
- Windows: Right-click the font file and choose 'Install'.

Once installed, the font will be available in applications like Adobe Illustrator, Photoshop, Microsoft Word, and more.

## 2. USING FONTS ON THE WEB

To use the font on your website:

1. Convert your font to .WOFF or .WOFF2 if needed.
2. Upload the font files to your server.
3. Use the following @font-face rule in your CSS:

```
@font-face {  
font-family: 'FontName';  
src: url('FontName.woff2') format('woff2'),  
url('FontName.woff') format('woff');  
font-weight: normal;  
font-style: normal;  
}
```

Then apply the font in CSS using:

```
body { font-family: 'FontName', sans-serif; }
```

## 3. USING LIGATURES

Many Authentype fonts include OpenType ligatures for improved character flow (e.g., 'fl', 'ff', 'fi').

In design software like Adobe Illustrator or InDesign:

- Select your text.
- Go to Character panel → Enable 'Standard Ligatures'.

In CSS:

```
font-feature-settings: 'liga' 1;
```

## 4. USING STYLISTIC SETS

Stylistic sets allow access to alternate glyphs such as swashes, alternate 'g', etc.

In Adobe apps:

- Open the Glyphs panel to explore alternates.
- Or enable specific sets via OpenType panel.

In CSS:

```
font-feature-settings: 'ss01' 1; /* for Stylistic Set 1 */
```

Refer to the font specimen or documentation to see available sets.

## 5. TROUBLESHOOTING

- Fonts not appearing? Try restarting your design app after installation.
- Ligatures/stylistic sets not showing? Make sure you're using software that supports OpenType features.
- Web preview issues? Check if your @font-face path is correct and browser supports WOFF/WOFF2.
